

# Project Tutorial: Heartfelt Blooms



## Project Supplies

### Stamps and Bundles

Heartfelt Blooms (Sale-a-Bration)

### Paper

Whisper White Thick Card Stock; one sheet of copy or scratch paper

### Ink

Rose Red Classic Stampin' Pads; Rose Red Stampin' Write Marker

### Accessories

Wink of Stella

### Tools

Stampin' Trimmer; Ruler

# Measurements

- Whisper White Thick Card Base: 4¼" x 11", scored at 5½"

# Instructions

1. Cut, score, and fold the Whisper White card base.
2. Using the Rose Red Stampin' Write Marker and a ruler, draw a horizontal line across the card base ¼" and ½" from the bottom. Rotate the card (so you're on the top of the card) and repeat: ¼" and ½" from the bottom edge.
3. Stamp the Heartfelt Blooms bouquet stamp centered in between the lines you just drew and the sides of the card base. Stamp the sentiment in the lower right corner, positioning it as close to the bouquet as possible.
4. Using the copy paper, stamp the bouquet again and then stamp the sentiment not too close to the flowers.
5. Fussy cut around the bouquet you stamped on the copy paper, then fussy cut around the sentiment.
6. Using a repositionable adhesive, adhere the copy paper images on top of the images stamped previously on the card base.
7. Open the Wink of Stella and make sure it is fairly heavily saturated. Using the Rose Red ink pad, squeeze some of the color onto the top of the stamp pad casing. Roll the brush of the Wink of Stella pen into the color in the top of the case.
8. Holding the Wink of Stella pen in one hand tap it against your other hand to create "spatters" over the card and masked images. You should see splats that are slightly coloured and some that are clear. Once you have the effect you want use the remaining copy paper to clean off the brush of the Wink of Stella pen. You should be able to clean it with just a few strokes.
9. Remove the masking images from the front of the card.
