

Project Tutorial: Merry Café



Project Supplies

Stamps and Bundles

Merry Café Photopolymer Stamp Set

Paper

Crushed Curry, Early Espresso, Tangerine Tango, Very Vanilla Cardstock; Painted Autumn Designer Series Paper

Ink

Early Espresso, Tangerine Tango Classic Stampin' Pads

Accessories

Burlap Ribbon; Linen Thread

Adhesives

Fast Fuse; Glue Dots; Stampin' Dimensionals

Tools

Stampin' Trimmer; Coffee Cup Framelits; Leaf Punch; Big Shot Die Cut Machine

Measurements

- Early Espresso Card Base: 4¼" x 11", scored at 5½"
- Painted Autumn Designer Series Paper: 4" x 5¼"
- Crushed Curry Card Stock, 4" x 1½"
- Tangerine Tango, 3" x 3"
- Very Vanilla Card Stock, 4" x 4"
- Burlap Ribbon, 4½"
- Linen Thread, 12"

Instructions

1. Cut, score, and fold the Early Espresso card base.
2. Using the Very Vanilla card stock, stamp the coffee cup, and lid in Early Espresso ink and stamp the Hello Fall sentiment in Tangerine Tango.
3. Die cut the cup, lid, and sentiment (using the wrapper die) with the Big Shot.
4. Using just the coffee cup die, cut another cup out of the Painted Autumn Designer Series Paper.
5. Adhere the Painted Autumn paper onto the Very Vanilla cup base and then adhere the Hello Fall wrapper over the DSP on the cup.
6. Using the linen thread, wrap around the cup just above the wrapper and tie in a bow.
7. Trim the Burlap Ribbon ends in a manner that is pleasing to you.
8. Assemble the card as follows:
 - a. Attach the Autumn Harvest DSP to the card base.
 - b. Place the Crushed Curry card stock piece about 2¼" from the bottom of the card.
 - c. Using Fast Fuse, adhere the Burlap Ribbon in the center of the Crushed Curry piece.
 - d. Adhere the coffee cup and lid as shown, using dimensionals.
 - e. Place a glue dot on the underside of the end of each of the punched leaves and then tuck them under the top and bottom sides of the cup. Arrange the leaf shapes so one of the leaves lies on top of the cup base.
